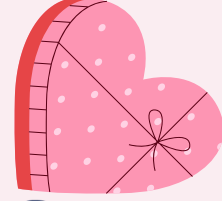

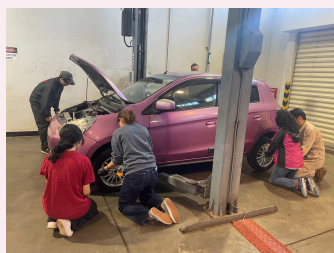
Presidents' Day: Honoring Leadership and Service
