## RYUKYU INDIGO DYEING WORKSHOP

Why don't you experience the one and only "RYUKYU BLUE" hand dyeing that can only be done with Ryukyu indigo dyeing? While checking the color after dyeing and exposing it to the air, it is dyed over and over again to bring out an even more beautiful indigo color. Even if the same dye is used for the same amount of time, if the humidity, temperature, and weather are different, the dyeing method, color, and density will be completely different. Unlike chemical dyes, which can produce multiple copies of the same product, there are areas that are difficult to achieve even if you aim for them. Aizome is truly a once-in-a-lifetime chance. It is a dyeing method that takes a lot of time and effort, but why not experience one in the world?
