• We also offer the Military Set Aside housing program. This program offers military discounts to active duty personnel only. The participating apartments waive security deposits; move in fees, and employment verification. The military member only has to sign a 12 month lease, pay the first month's rent and set up an allotment.

### 6. SINGLE PERSONAL HOUSING

All single personal, Sergeant and below, must live in the barracks. Sergeants may apply for BAH own/right on a case by case basis.

# 7. PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

The National Capital Region offers transit subsidy for military, civilian and NAF employees paid and employed by the Department of Defense, and permanently stationed and working in the National Capital Region.
