BAH POLICY UPDATE

Great news for "geo-bachelors" whose families are based in higher cost-of-living areas. The Navy now authorizes Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) based on your dependents' location. This change applies to members who have dependents at the previous duty station or previously authorized dependent location in the Continental United States (CONUS), Alaska, and Hawaii. SAVINGS DEPOSIT PROGRAM

Sailors supporting combat operations can now access the <u>DOD Savings Deposit Program</u>, helping them save money abroad. You may qualify for the program if you serve in a designated combat zone, direct support area, or receive hostile fire/imminent danger pay in a Qualified Hazardous Duty Area (QHDA). This savings account allows you to earn 10% interest on your deposit and withdraw every quarter through <u>myPay</u> after reaching \$10,000. If you're still sorting out childcare at your next duty station, you can now claim up to \$500 CONUS or \$1500 OCONUS for the cost of bringing a nanny or non-dependent family member with you.
