Welcome to Marine Corps Base Smedley D. Butler, Okinawa Japan! The information and links below provide relevant information on DoDEA Schools. Base Housing boundaries and Quarters address will determine your zoned school.

Documents required for registration:

Birth Certificate (PreK, Kinder and 1st Grade)

Immunization Documentation, PCS Orders, Area Clearance

Previous school records and Housing Assignment Letter (obtain after housing assigned).

How to Register:

Sponsor and student must physically be on island to complete enrollment. Once you have a home address, you may pre-enroll at <https://dodeasis.myfollett.com/aspn/logon.do> complete and/or upload any of the documents. If unable to upload the documents, please hand carry to your zoned school(s).

NOTICE: Once on island: a visit to the school is required to finalize the registration process.

**** Families are not required to pre-register online. You may choose to fully register in person ****

Once you finalized enrollment, you may set up your child's lunch account. Families are also encouraged to apply for the Free & Reduced lunch under the School Services tab.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will my child begin school? It normally takes 2 business days to process registration forms for your child(ren) to begin school.

Can I enroll my child before I have accepted housing? While in temporary quarters, you can register your child at the school zoned for your temporary quarters. Once you accept housing, your child may have to change schools if the house is within a different school zone.

My child is on an IEP: Please be sure to inform the registrar of your child's IEP during registration. It is also imperative that you provide a copy of your child's current IEP to the school.

When can my child begin PreK and/or Kindergarten? Students must turn 4 years old by 1 September to enroll in PreK and 5 years old by 1 September to enroll into Kindergarten.
