USMC Tuition Assistance (TA) Brief

This brief is a requirement for all Marines who are first time TA users. Participants will review the Marine Corps TA policies and the local process for requesting TA.

GI Bill Brief

Explains the differences between the Montgomery GI Bill and the Post 9/11 GI Bill. In addition, Marines will learn all the advantages of each type of GI Bill and how they can apply for and use these benefits.

USMAP/MCCOOL Brief

Marines will learn about apprenticeship and credentialing opportunities for their MOS to become better at their job while on active-duty and be better prepared to transition to civilian employment after leaving active-duty service.

Training in the Trades Brief

This workshop will explore vocational and trade education and training. Navigate pursuing a vocation or trade-industry career, learn how to utilize the GI Bill and discover other financial resources to fund your education.

DoD SkillBridge Brief

AFCT (Armed Forces Classification Test)

This in-service equivalent of the ASVAB measures aptitude and abilities necessary for a Marine's or Sailor's successful performance on the job and during formal school training.

Authorization letter required to test

Air University

Previously known as AFIADL, these exams are part of the DoD and Air Force Distance Learning Program. Administered to Marines and MCBJ Fire Firefighters only.

ASTB (Aviation Selection Test Battery)

This exam is used in the selection process for all Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard aviation programs, and other select officer programs.

The OAR (a portion of the ASTB) is also available.

DLAB (Defense Language Aptitude Battery)

This exam is designed to aid in the selection of the personnel for language school training. Measures an individuals' aptitude to learn a new language.

DLPT (Defense Language Proficiency Test)

This exam is designed to determine proficiency in a specific foreign language. College credit is recommended based upon level of proficiency. Specialized language testing can be requested if computer-based exams are not available.

TABE (Test of Adult Basic Education)

TABE stands for Test of Adult Basic Education and includes reading, language and math subtests. This test is Available upon request for those seeking to request lateral moves into counter-intelligence or EOD.
