AFCT (Armed Forces Classification Test)

This in-service equivalent of the ASVAB measures aptitude and abilities necessary for a Marine's or Sailor's successful performance on the job and during formal school training.

Air University

These exams are part of the DoD and Air Force Distance Learning Program. Administered to Marines and MCBJ Fire Firefighters only.

ASTB (Aviation Selection Test Battery)

This exam is used in the selection process for all Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard aviation programs, and other select officer programs. The Officer Aptitude Rating (OAR) is also available.

PearsonVUE / AMP / PSI

As an authorized site, we offer various certification exams through these testing agencies. Please contact us for more info.

DLAB (Defense Language Aptitude Battery)

This exam is designed to support the selection of personnel for language school training by assessing an individual's aptitude for learning a new language.

DLPT (Defense Language Proficiency Test)

This exam is designed to assess proficiency in a specific foreign language. College credit may be recommended based on the individual's demonstrated level of proficiency. Specialized language testing can be requested when computer-based exams are not available.

TABE (Test of Adult Basic Education)

The Test of Adult Basic Education or TABE assesses reading, language, and math skills. This test is available upon request for individuals seeking lateral moves into counterintelligence or Explosive Ordnance Disposal.
