USGA Rules Govern All Play

Help us make your round enjoyable and protect our golf course.

KLIPPER COURSE POLICIES:

- All players must register with starter.
- Each player must have their own set of clubs.
- All players must check in 15 minutes before tee times.
- Personal coolers, outside food and beverages, tank tops, muscle shirts, cut-offs, swim suits, bare midriffs, boots and slippers are prohibited.
- Keep electric golf carts away from greens and tees.
- Children under 10 not allowed on golf course.
- Use of range balls not allowed on golf course.
- Provisional Ball: In accordance with APPENDIX I-A-2b. In the event a player is unsure that their ball is lost in a lateral water hazard on #15, they may play a provisional ball to speed up play.

No entry is allowed into environmentally sensitive areas as defined by red stakes with green tops. Holes affected are 6, 7, 10, 12, 13, 14, & 15. These are defined as "No Play Zones." When a ball is in a "No Play Zone" within a penalty area, the ball must NOT be played as it lies and relief MUST be taken under Rule 17.1e. If your ball lies outside the area but your stance would be inside the area, you MUST take relief without penalty. Playing in these areas are subject to a 2 stroke penalty for playing from the wrong place.

Mokapu Peninsula

The Mokapu Peninsula, one of the most aesthetic places on Oahu in terms of natural beauty, is steeped in Hawaiian tradition. Its very name, "Mokapu," means "Sacred Lands." Ancient Hawaiians buried thousands of their dead in the sand dunes located along Holes 13, 14 and 15.

These sand dunes are sacred to Hawaiians and are listed in the National Register of Historic Places. In 1949, as part of the Naval Air Station, the first nine holes were constructed. In 1951, as part of the Marine Corps Air Station, Kaneohe Bay, construction began on the second nine holes and was completed in 1952.
